## FLEXIBLE WORK ARRANGEMENTS (FWA) INCLUDING SERCAT 6

Flexible work arrangements (FWA) including SERCAT 6 can be utilised at any time after the completion of your initial employment training.

Flexible working arrangements **do not** affect your total hours worked each fortnight. They are arranged with your Chain of Command and may include:

- WORKING FROM HOME
- ANOTHER LOCATION
- **✓** IRREGULAR HOURS



Long-term arrangements should be confirmed using form AE406, particularly if you are seeking remote overseas work as this must be approved by Career Management - Army.

SERCAT 6 is used if you intend to reduce the amount of hours you work in a fortnight on a regular recurring pattern.



This could be in response to:

- → FAMILY REQUIREMENTS
- → STUDY COMMITMENTS
- → WORKING OUTSIDE ARMY

## You should discuss this decision with your CHAIN OF COMMAND and CAREER MANAGER

so you can understand the impact on your salary and entitlements as well as any outstanding service obligations.

## **APPROVED**

SERCAT 6 arrangements cannot start until they have been approved by Career Management - Army.



All new requests, extensions or amendments must be received by Career Management - Army at least 28 days before your start date.

This ensures all pay and entitlement changes are processed prior to transfer so you do not incur an overpayment.
